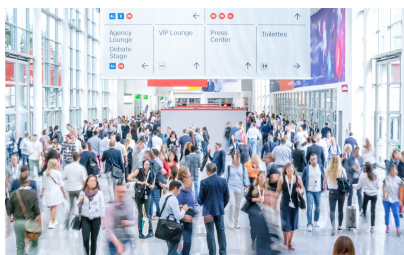


Career and Internship Fair
