

Nordson BUILDS Scholarship Program

Last year, over 85 students nationwide were awarded Nordson BUILDS Scholarships which range from \$4,000 to \$10,000. Plus, scholarship recipients get exclusive primary access to internship opportunities and employment opportunities after graduation. Most business majors are eligible to apply: Business, Marketing, Supply Chain Management, Accounting, and Finance. Applicants must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
