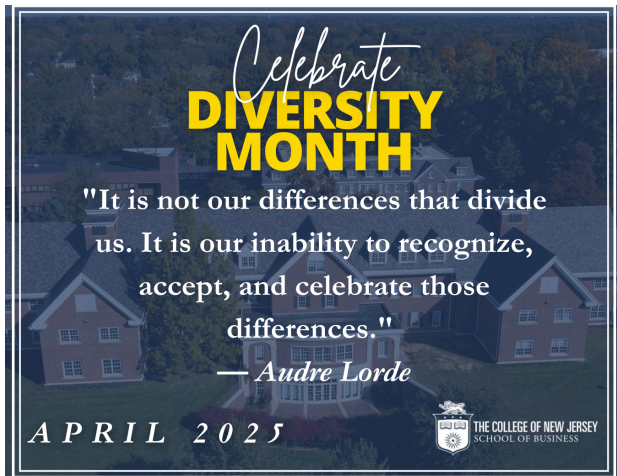

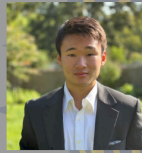


Student Organization Highlight
