Student Travel

Students or student organizations planning to travel *must* read the <u>Student Travel Request Procedure</u>. The procedure has been revised since last year. **Note: Per TCNJ policy, any student traveling as a member of a student organization, regardless of receiving funding, must complete required travel forms.**

The School of Business can *assist* your organization with funding for travel. Review the Student Travel Request Procedure, before submitting a funding request. Requests for fall travel funding are due by **September 15th** and for winter/spring travel by **January 15th**. If you have any questions, please email Stephanie Horner at horners@tcnj.edu.

NEW: Non-Travel Funding Requests

Due to the overwhelming number of non-travel funding requests from Student Organizations last semester, we have established a procedure for these types of requests (e.g., financial assistance for an event). Organizations *must* show that they have applied for <u>SFB Funding</u> and proof of organization fundraising efforts. Review the <u>Non-Travel Funding Request Procedure</u> before submitting a funding request. Requests must be submitted at least 3 weeks prior to the event. Accounting Career Planning: Wednesday, August 27th, 10 am to 11 am, Physics Building room 101.
