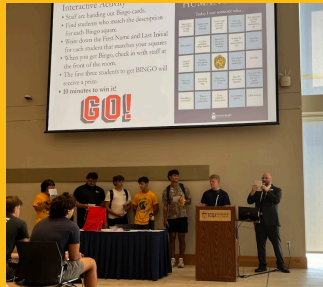

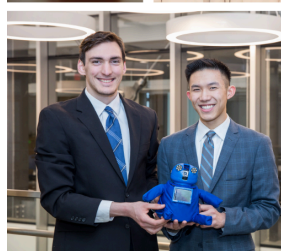
Mayo Business Plan Competition
